Key Priority 1: Improving understanding of number

Targets

- An increased number of students will achieve in the Higher Bands of NAPLAN Numeracy each year
- All students who previously achieved in the Higher Bands for NAPLAN Numeracy will remain in the Higher Bands in their next NAPLAN test

Strategies

Educators will:

- work with the Senior Leader Learning Improvement Primary to use the learning design process to plan for developing the Proficiencies in Australian Curriculum: Mathematics (understanding, fluency, problem-solving and reasoning)
- work collaboratively to design formative assessment practices that support numeracy learning
- explicitly plan and deliver numeracy lessons that focus on developing the Big Ideas in Number concepts

Key Priority 2: Improving writing

Targets

- An increased number of students will achieve in the Higher Bands of NAPLAN Writing each year
- All students who previously achieved in the Higher Bands for NAPLAN Writing will remain in the Higher Bands in their next NAPLAN test
- All learners will show improvement from one moderated written piece to the next, using the relevant Brightpath ruler

Strategies

Educators will:

- work collaboratively, using Brightpath resources to moderate student written work & design learning for improved student writing
- use bookmaking strategies in the Early Years classrooms [[link to QIP](#)]
- work collaboratively to design formative assessment practices that support literacy learning
